- New exam development for wastewater disciplines is scheduled to begin this fall.
- WPI's Certification Commission will be meeting in September for strategic planning.
- John Solvie presented on exam development to the Nevada Water & Wastewater Forum at the
   March meeting in Reno.eed to update ABC to WPI (Water Professionals International) as they have changed their name
- Exam development has started for next round of standardized exams, met in June in Chicago starting the first steps, which is creating a new job analysis
  - Member Solvie ABC (Association of Boards of Certification) has been rebranded as WPI (Water Professionals International).
  - Member Solvie's previous WPI role as Chair of the Certification Commission for Environmental Professionals is now a designated position on WPI's Board of Directors.
  - WPI initiatives currently include new exam development, model standards initiative, and plant point rating systems.
  - AWWA & WEF are working with states on establishing interstate compacts to facilitate reciprocity.
  - John will providing be providing an overview of WPI exam development to the Nevada Operators
    Forum.
  - WEF appointed John to serve on its Stormwater Committee.
  - Member Diamond AH HA moment at the ABC Conference: Understanding why they have the extra 10 questions on the exam.
  - Member Baratti AH HA moment at the ABC Conference: the process on how people can take tests and how that can help with memory retrieval the more you use the subject.
  - PA Jacobson AH HA moment at the ABC Conference: ABC is putting together a guideline for each state regarding approval of CEUs and their requirements to approve CEUs.
